1.To carry on the business of manufacturers, traders, developers, designers, assemblers, installers, maintainers, processors, repairers, buyers, sellers, importers, exporters, agents, brokers, and dealers in all kinds of cookers, pressure cookers, domestic and commercial cookers, electric rice cookers, electric pressure cookers, all kinds of bottles including stainless steel bottles (SS bottles), vacuum flask bottles and all other kinds of material bottles; all kinds of tiffins, food jars, storage jars, and steel containers; all kinds of nonstick cookware, hard anodized cookware, tablewares, cookware and pressure cookers, pans, fry pans, kadais, tawas, ovens, stoves, baking machines, kitchen and home appliances, kitchenware, homeware, tablewares, cutlery, and other cookware and all cooking range products. 2. To carry on the business of manufacturers, assemblers, developers, designers, installers, maintainers, repairers, buyers, sellers, importers, exporters, agents, brokers, and dealers in all types of consumer kitchen products

1.To buy all kinds of plant, equipment, machinery, apparatus, tools, utensils, Commodities, substances, articles and things necessary or useful carrying on the main business of the Company. 2.To enter

into agreement with any company persons for obtaining by grant license or on such other terms of all types, formulae and such other rights and benefits, technical information, know-how and expert guidance and equipment and machinery and things mentioned herein above and to arrange facilities for training of technical personnel by them.

3. To apply the assets of the Company in any way or towards the establishment, maintenance or extension of any association, institution or fund in any way connected with any particular trade or business or with trade or commerce and particularly with the trade, including any association, institution or fund for the interests of masters, owners and employers against loss by bad debt, strike, combustion, fire, accident or otherwise or for the benefit of any employeeworkman or others at any time employed by the company or any of its predecessors in business or their families or dependents and whether or not in common with such other persons or classes of persons and in particular of friendly, cooperative and such other societies, reading rooms, libraries, educational and charitable institutions, dining and recreation rooms, churches, chapels, schools, and hospitals and to grant gratuities, pensions and allowances and to contribute to any funds raised by public or local subscription for any purpose.

4. To establish, provide, maintain and conduct or otherwise, subsidies research laboratories and experimental workshops for scientific and technical research and experiments and to undertake and carry on with all scientific and technical research, experiments and tests of all kinds and to promote studies and research both scientific and technical investigation and to promote studies and research both scientific and technical investigation and invention by providing, subsidising, endowing or assisting laboratories, workshops, libraries, lectures, meetings and conferences and by providing the remuneration to scientific and technical professors and teachers and to award, scholarships, prizes, grants and bursaries to students and to encourage, promote and reward studies, researches, investigations, experiments, tests and inventions of any kind that may be considered likely to assist them in business of the Company.

To open accounts with any bank or financial institution and to draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, hundies, bills of lading, warrants, debentures and such other negotiable or transferable instruments of all types and to buy the same. 15. Subject to sections 58-A and 292/ 293, 295 and 372A of the Companies Act, 1956 and the Regulations made therein and the directions issued by Reserve Bank of India to borrow, raise or secure the payment of money or to receive money as a loan, at interest for any of the objects of the company and at such time or times as may be expedient, by promissory notes, bills of exchange, hundies, bills of lading, warrants or such other negotiable instruments of all types or by taking credit in or opening current accounts or overdraft accounts with any person, firm, bank or company and whether with or without any security or by such other means, as may be deemed expedient, and in particular by the issue of debentures or debenture stock, perpetual or otherwise and in security for any such moneys borrowed, raised or received and of any such debentures or debenture stock so issued, to mortgage, pledge or charge the whole or any part of the property and assets of the Company both present and future, including its uncalled capital, by special assignment or otherwise or to transfer or convey the same absolutely or in trust and to give the lenders power of sale and other powers as may seem expedient and to purchase, redeem or pay off such securities provided that the Company shall not carry on the business of banking within the meaning of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949. 16. Subject to the provisions of section 77 of the Companies Act, 1956, to invest other than investment in the company's own shares and deal with money of the Company not immediately required in such shares or upon securities or investments and in such manner as may from time to time, be determined. 17. To provide for the welfare of employees or ex-employees (including Directors and other officers) of the Company and the wives and families or the dependents or connections of such persons, by building or contributing to the building of houses, or dwellings or chawls or by grants of money, pensions, allowances, bonus or other such payments or be creating and from time to time, subscribing or contributing to provident fund and other associations, institutions, funds or trusts, and/ or by providing or subscribing or contributing towards places of instruction and recreation, hospitals and dispensaries, medical and such other attendances and assistance as the Company shall determine. 22. To undertake and execute any trusts, the undertaking of which may seem desirable, either gratuitously or otherwise, for the attainment of the main objects of the Company. 23. To procure the incorporation, registration or such other recognition of the Company in the country, state or place outside India and to establish and maintain local registers and branch places of the main business in any part of the world. 24. To adopt such means of making known the business of the Company as may seem expedient and in particular by advertising in the press, by circulars, by purchase and exhibition of works of art or interest, by publication of books and periodicals and by granting prizes, rewards and donations or holding exhibitions. 25. To send out to foreign countries, its directors, employees or any other person or designation possibilities of main business or trade procuring and buying or establishing trade and business connections or for promoting the Company and to pay all expenses incurred in this connection. 28. To do all such other things as may be deemed incidental or conducive to the attainment of the main objects. 29. To assist any company or others such enterprise in its dealings with any Government local, statutory and such other authority whether in India or abroad in the legitimate pursuit of its activities, and to procure capital for any company or enterprises. 30. To carry on the business of manufactures of importers, exporters and dealers in men's, women's and children's clothing, wearing apparel, hosiery goods, carpets, durries, mats, rugs, blankets and others similar articles of every kind, nature and description made from cotton, synthetic, wool, worsted materials and/or leather. 31. To carry on the business of importers and exporters, shipowners, shipbuilders, charter of ship and such other vessels of all types, warehousemen, ships and insurance brokers, forwarding agents and wharfingers. 40. To carry on the business as proprietors and publishers of newspapers, periodicals, journals, books, and such other literary works and undertakings of all types. 41. To carry on the business as manufacturers of and dealers in all kinds of natural and synthetic rubbers, elastomers, synthetic resin, latex and formulations thereof and all types of rubber products and goods. 42. To carry on the business as manufacturers of and dealers in leather and leather goods of all descriptions and of leather dressers, tanners, hides, skins and all things and material connected therewith. 43. To carry on the business as manufacturers of and dealers in all types of plastics and plastic products, furniture, fancy goods, stationery, provisions, drugs, medicines, chemicals, paints, and articles of household use and consumption. 44. However the company shall not engage in any business that is banned under the Banking Regulation Act, 1949. 57. To carry on the business of buyers, sellers, dealers, breeders, importers, and exporters of animals such as horses, dogs, cats, sheep, and cattle. 58. To own and run mobile clinics and hospitals for providing medical, veterinary, and surgical facilities in rural areas for milk-producing and other animals, and to maintain animals to maintain animals of all types, including dogs, cats, cattle, sheep, pigs, and horses, and to conduct trials of veterinary medicines and drugs on them for experimental and research purposes. 59. To acquire and hold shares, stocks, debentures, bonds, obligations, and securities issued or guaranteed by any company, association, or undertaking constituted for carrying on business in India or elsewhere. This includes debentures, bonds, obligations, and securities issued or guaranteed by the government municipality, public body, or other local authority. The company can acquire such shares, debentures, bonds, obligations, or securities by original subscription, tender purchase, exchange, or any other means. The company can also subscribe for them conditionally or unconditionally, guarantee their subscription, and exercise and enforce all rights and powers associated with their ownership. Additionally, the company can sell or otherwise dispose of any such shares, debentures, bonds, obligations, or securities. 32. To act as stockists, commission agent, manufacturers, representatives, or agents selling and purchasing agents, indenting agents, distributors, brokers, trustees, attorneys in goods mentioned in the main objects. 60. To carry on all kinds of business as manufacturers, importers, exporters, dealers, and distributors of television films, videofilms, tapes, and videocassettes. This includes equipment, accessories, parts, tools, materials, apparatus, and other articles used in connection with them or which may hereafter be invented. 61. To carry on the profession of consultants on management, employment, engineering, industrial, and technical matters to industry and business. The company can also act as employment agents

and exporters of manpower. 62. To carry on business as manufacturers, dealers, stockists, exporters, and importers of all other hardware items of all types and descriptions. 63. To carry on business as manufacturers, dealers, stockists, importers, and exporters of packing materials, cartons, containers, boxes, and cases made of paper, boards, wood, glass, plastic, pulp, cellulose, films, polyethylene, rubber, metals, metal foils, gelatin, tin-flexible, treated, laminated, or other materials. 64. To engage in the business of tour operators and travel agents and all other services incidental to it. 65. To carry on the business of purchase and sale of petroleum and petroleum products, to act as dealers and distributors for petroleum companies, to run service stations for the repairs and servicing of automobiles. 66. To carry on the business of manufacturers and dealers of tractors, automobiles, automatic and semi-automatic vehicles, earthmoving equipment, cycles, mopeds, and any other such vehicles of all types. 67. To carry on the business of manufacturers and dealers of cement, lime burners and ceramics, sanitary fittings and china wares. 68. To carry on hotel, motel and catering business and to secure sound investments of foreign capital in Indian undertakings and enterprises and Indian Capital in foreign undertakings and enterprises. 69. To manufacture, buy, sell, lease, import, export, alter, improve, manipulate, prepare for market, exchange, install, repair, service, let on hire and deal in all kinds of, surgicals, X-ray units, X-ray equipments, telecommunication machines, business machines, intercoms, teleprinters, dictating and recording machines, broadcasting apparatuses, loudspeakers, radios, autoradios, reverberators, tape-player, cassette tapes, headphones, stereo complex speakers, radio control equipments, cameras, binoculars, microscopes, projectors, telescope television sets, refrigerators, air conditioners, coolers, radars, computers and their spare parts and to establish, provide, maintain and conduct research and such other laboratories, training colleges, schools and such other institutions for the training, education and instruction of students and others who may desire to avail themselves of the same and to provide for the delivery and holding of lectures, demonstrations, exhibitions, classes, meetings and conferences in connection therewith. 70. To install the Electric furnaces for melting steel scrap and for producing steel castings and for re-rolling mild steel sections. 71. To manufacture steel castings of all kinds such as used for Textile Machine parts, Railways, Tramways, Motor parts, Tractors, Sugar industry, Cement industry and machinery parts. 72. To weld steel tubes and boring of different steel and galvanizing iron sections.

(ii) to the costs, charges and expenses of winding up (and for the adjustment of the rights of the contributories among themselves), such amount as may be required, not exceeding \*  rupees.
